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The first page of the manuscript must include:

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- 2. Names of authors, including first names and academic degrees.
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The second page should contain an abstract of not more than 150 words. The abstract should be factual, not descriptive, and should present the reason for the study, the main findings (give specific data if possible), and the principal conclusions. Do not include a summary.

MANUSCRIPT

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Data presented in tables should be self-explanatory and should supplement, not duplicate, the text or figures. Excessive tabular data are discouraged. Each table should be provided on a separate page. Tables and figures should be numbered consecutively and indicated in parentheses when they are mentioned, [ie, (Table I), (Figure I)]. Important: Figures should be separate items and saved in an eps, tif, or jpg format, minimum 300 dpi. Legends should be included for all tables and figures.

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
